## BLIND TRUST WHITE 2024

**INSIDER TIP:** The name "Sauvignon Blanc" comes from the French words Sauvage (wild) and blanc (white). The sauvignon blanc grape was first mentioned in literature in 1477 and was widely planted in the Bordeaux region by the 1600s.

### Wine Profile

A blind trust is a financial trust in which the executors have full discretion over the assets, and the trust beneficiaries have no knowledge of the holdings of the trust. In this case, our Blind Trust is a wine in which the winemaker has full discretion over the blend, so you'll just have to trust us. The Blind Trust White was first produced between 2011 and 2014 and was brought back in 2022. The 2024 vintage is the third vintage of this reimagined wine.

### Tasting Notes

The 2024 Blind Trust White displays aromas of peach and nectarine with a perfumed floral lift. The wine offers a mix of citrus and stone fruit flavors. The acidity quenches the palate and adds to the long and flavorful finish. The 2024 Blind Trust White will pair beautifully with a lightly spiced Thai green chicken curry or grilled shrimp and scallops.

### Winemaking Notes

With the harsh winter of 2024 reeking havoc on vineyards, we had a small amount of Sauvignon Blanc to work with. The wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks to preserve the freshness of this variety; no oak or concrete was used in the making of this wine.

### Vintage Notes

The Okanagan's 2024 freeze event was an unprecedented shake-up—one that tested even the most diversified portfolios. While our vineyards weather the storm and we continue to invest in the future, we remain committed to crafting wines that meet the high standards of our shareholders.

This year, we are producing a select few wines from our BC harvest, supported by our carefully managed

inventory. Behind the scenes, our team has also explored thoughtful ways to adapt our sourcing for the future—strategically and selectively—ensuring we maintain the standards and style you've come to expect. We will be introducing one limited-edition release featuring fruit sourced from the Pacific Northwest—an opportunity to showcase the strength of diversification in winemaking. Working closely with a trusted network of esteemed vineyards in Washington state, our winemaking team has meticulously overseen every step—from vineyard selection to fermentation—to uphold the precision, structure, and quality that define Laughingstock Vineyards. More information on that will be released later this year.
